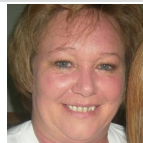

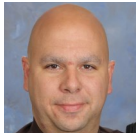

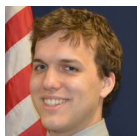

Emergency Chaplains of East Tennessee

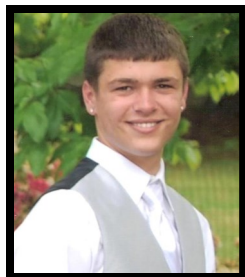
