Guest speaker for the evening will be Chief David Hess. Chief Hess has served as Chief of Police in Roxboro, NC since 2015 and is the past president of the NC Association of Chiefs of Police.

CHAPLAIN FIELD REPORTS

One chaplain responded to minister to officers after an armed suspect opened fire on them and shot a K-9 (police dog) at point blank range. The subject was arrested after a standoff. No additional injuries were reported. The dog is expected to make a full recovery.

A chaplain in Western NC was requested to assist a 911 Center following a difficult call. The chaplain was able to provide counsel for several staff members at the center.

Multiple chaplains from Person County participated in a "Blessing of the Hands" for staff at Person Memorial Hospital for Nurse's Week.

A young man was robbed and murdered out of state. Local law enforcement officers were contacted to notify next of kin. A chaplain responded to assist officers as they went to a residence to deliver the

death notification to the man's parents. Chaplains and the Grief Team will follow up.

Chaplain responded to assist on a homicide scene. The chaplain was on scene for two hours caring for the mother of the deceased while waiting for family to arrive from out of town.

During a ride along, a chaplain was able to share the Gospel with a first responder, who then prayed to receive Christ as their Savior!

Chaplain assisted NC Highway Patrol in Pitt County with death notifications following a motor vehicle accident that resulted in the death of multiple teenagers.

EMS responded for an adult in cardiac arrest. Resuscitation efforts were made for 45 minutes but were not successful. The subject was

pronounced dead on scene. Heroin overdose suspected. Chaplain was called to minister to family members who had treated the subject with Narcan and performed CPR prior to EMS arrival.

Chaplain ministered on scene of a suicide. Officers had been on scene earlier due to a domestic situation involving the deceased.

Chaplain assisted family and first responders following a line of duty death of a firefighter. The chaplain was able to provide care at the hospital as well as follow-up care after the incident.

Following a fatal motor vehicle accident, a chaplain responded to the scene. The chaplain worked with multiple agencies while on scene and also provided care for the other driver that was involved in the accident.
